ABOUT LIFELINE

Lifeline is a federal program that ensures qualifying low income customers have access to high-quality voice or broadband services.

AM I ELIGIBLE?

To qualify for Lifeline service, you must either qualify for an eligible program or meet certain income requirements. Applicants need only meet one requirement or the other, not both. This benefit can only be used once per household.

QUALIFYING PROGRAMS

- Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), formerly known as Food Stamps
- Medicaid
- Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
- Federal Public Housing Assistance (FPHA)
- Veterans Pension and Survivors Benefit
- Tribal Programs – must live on federally recognized tribal lands and also qualify for one of the following:
 - Any of the federal assistance programs listed above
 - Bureau of Indian Affairs General Assistance
 - Head Start (only households meeting the income qualifying standard)
 - Tribal Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (Tribal TANF)
 - Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations

-OR-

INCOME REQUIREMENTS

Individuals are eligible if their household income is 135% or less than the Federal Poverty Guidelines.

Size of Household	Maximum Household Income
1	\$21,533
2	\$29,093
3	\$36,653
4	\$44,213
For each additional person add	\$7,560

HOW DO I QUALIFY?

SHOW PROOF OF QUALIFYING PROGRAM PARTICIPATION

You will need a card, letter, or official document from the qualifying program that shows that you, a child, or a dependent participates. This documentation will also need to include an expiration date or timeframe of participation.

-OR-

SHOW PROOF OF QUALIFYING HOUSEHOLD INCOME

You will need documentation confirming your household income. Common forms of acceptable documentation include the most current tax return or tribal tax return, current income statement from an employer, your last three months of paycheck stubs, Social Security statement of benefits, or your unemployment/workers' compensation statement of benefits.

ELIGIBLE FORMS OF ID

You'll also need a valid government issued ID such as a Driver License, State ID Card, US Passport, Military ID, or Tribal ID. ID Must be current, not expired and in good physical condition. No rips or tears. Additionally, please bring proof of your social security number to complete your application.
