3. SCHEDULE OF CHARGES (cont'd)

3.10 Direct Access Arrangement - provides dedicated access line to a GCICC terminal location.

3.10.1 Each Port Access: \$200.00 installation charge; \$100.00 monthly recurring.

3.10.2 Waiver of Port Access Charge: Each access arrangement which accumulates in excess of 40 hours usage per month will have the port access charge for that month waived.

3.10.3 Waiver of Installation Charge: Customers who subscribe for a minimum service period of one year will have the installation charge waived.

3.10.4 Termination of Arrangement: The arrangement may be terminated at any time upon 30 days notice to GCICC.

3.11 Authorization Codes

First Code: No Charge

Additional Codes:
(limited to 10 per customer) \$5 monthly recurring

3.12 Telephone Management Reports

Call records on magnetic tape \$100 per tape

3.13 Charges or Credits for Part of a Month

Where rates are stated on a monthly basis, each month is considered to have 30 days for billing purposes. Charges or credits for a fractional part of a month are calculated by counting the number of days remaining in the billing period after the service is furnished or discontinued and dividing that number by 30 days.

3.14 Satellite Cross-Linked Call Completion Service

Satellite Cross-Linked Call Completion Service refers to calls, originated by GCICC long distance customers, and terminated to mobile phones by cross-connecting the call through a satellite-to-satellite system. Calls terminate at any location worldwide, depending on the terminating phone's location at the time of the call.

The applicable rate to GCICC long distance customers for this call type is based on the satellite routing requirements of the terminating phone. Satellite Cross-Linked Call Completion Service is rated in one-minute increments at the following rate:

First Minute:	\$2.99	R
Additional minutes:	\$2.99 per minute	R

The following are the country codes used to identify Satellite Cross-Linked Call Completion Service:

The Satellite Cross-Linked Call Completion rate is applicable 24 hours a day.

4. SPECIAL SERVICES AND ARRANGEMENTS

Rates and charges for special services and/or arrangements will be based on the costs incurred by GCICC and may include (A) non-recurring type charges, (B) recurring type charges, (C) termination liabilities, (D) underutilization liabilities, or (E) combinations thereof. Such rates and charges will be set forth on an individual case basis.

5. CONFERENCE SERVICE

This section sets forth the rates and charges applicable to international conference calls processed by GCI Communication.

5.1 General

5.1.1 Conference Service is the furnishing of telecommunications between a calling station and two or more called stations. All stations on a conference connection may communicate with each other. Conference Service may be established to a specific person or to a specific telephone number/station.

5.1.2 Conference Service rates, including a surcharge per each called station, apply between the calling station (conference call originator) and each called station on a conference call. There can be a maximum of 23 called stations and one originator per conference call. Z T

5.2 Initial Periods

5.2.1 The initial period for Conference Service calls is the initial period for "Operator Station" for the applicable country in sections C 3.8 and C 3.9. Z

5.3 Additional Periods

5.3.1 The additional period for Conference Service calls is the additional period for "Operator" for the applicable country in sections C 3.8 and C 3.9 T

5.4 Rate Calculation

5.4.1 The total rate shall be the sum of the initial period rate and the product of the additional period rate times the number of additional periods per international called station plus the appropriate surcharges. T T

5. CONFERENCE SERVICE (cont'd)

5.5 Timing of Calls

5.5.1 Chargeable time begins when connection is established between all stations on the conference call and ends when the connection is terminated when the last station hangs up, except as provided in the following:
Chargeable time does not include time lost because of faults or defects in the service.

5.6 Billing Arrangements

5.6.1 Charges for a conference call are billed in total only. The charge for a conference call may be billed to the originating station, a Calling Card, approved Credit Card or another designated station subject to the following: The total conference call charge will be billed to only one station or to one Calling Card (i.e. the Company will not prorate or otherwise divide the charges between two or more stations), or the total conference call charge may be billed to a station, other than the origination station, if the designated station agrees to pay the charge.

5.6.2 The origination station and the designation billed station must be located in Alaska, the continuous United States, Hawaii, or Canada.

5.7 Schedule of Charges

5.7.1 Charges for Conference Service Calls for countries other than Canada use the Person-to-Person rates in Section C 3.8 for the applicable country.

5.7.2 Charges for Conference Service calls for Canada use the 1201-2000 mileage band Person-to-Person rates in Section C 3.9.2.
