This tariff contains the regulations and rates applicable to International Communication Service provided by GCI COMMUNICATION CORP. (GCICC), between United States points referenced herein and Foreign Countries or Territories.

# SECTION A - DEFINITIONS OF TERMS

For the purpose of this tariff, the following definitions shall apply:

## Access Line

A dedicated arrangement which connects a customer location to a GCICC terminal location.

## Administrative Change

The modification of an existing circuit or service at the customer's request which does not involve the physical rearrangement of a circuit or facility or the reprogramming of service features. An administrative change generally involves the adjustment of records or coordinating processes to include billing record changes.

## Authorization Code

A multi-digit code, one or more of which are available to customers to enable them to identify individual users or groups of users, and thereby allocate the costs of their long distance service.

#### Authorized User

A person, firm, corporation or other entity authorized by the customer to receive or send communications.

## Billing Record Change

A change in customer billing address.

## Cancellation of Order

A customer initiated request to discontinue processing a service order, either in part or in its entirety, prior to its completion. (This differs from a Disconnection.)

## Calling Circle

As used in conjunction with the Friends & Family Program, a Calling Circle is a group of up to twenty-one (21) U.S. telephone numbers (excluding Puerto Rico and the U.S. Virgin Islands), including the number of the Subscriber, and up to three (3) telephone numbers in international locations served by GCI (including Puerto Rico and U.S. Virgin Islands). Within the group of 21 U.S. telephone numbers (excluding the Subscriber) all Alaska telephone numbers must be presubscribed to GCI for interstate service and all telephone numbers in the other 49 states must be presubscribed to MCI.

Telephone numbers which are not capable of being presubscribed to an interexchange carrier, and telephone numbers which are associated with GCI or MCI 800 Service (other than those associated with Personal 800), or MCI 900 Service, payphone numbers, DID telephone numbers, institutional telephone numbers and numbers associated with GCI or MCI services other than switched services will not be eligible for inclusion in Calling Circles.

The international telephone numbers may be changed not more than once during the Subscriber's monthly billing cycle.

## Company

## Conference Call

The term conference call denotes a call which connects three or more main station or private branch exchanges, or combinations thereof, on one connection at the same time..

## Conference Call Originator

The term conference call originator denotes the originating station on a conference call.

## Customer

The person, firm, corporation or other entity which orders service and is responsible for the payment of charges.

## Customer-Provided Terminal Equipment

Terminal equipment, as defined herein, provided by a customer.

## Disconnection

The discontinuance of an existing circuit, dedicated access line, port connection, or other service. (This differs from a Cancellation.)

## **GCI** Terminal Location

Any location where GCICC maintains its facilities.

## **Installation**

The establishment of a circuit, dedicated access line, port connection or other facilities for new or additional service.

## Joint User

A person, firm or corporation designated by the customer as a user of communication facilities furnished to the customer by GCICC, and to whom a portion of the charges for such facilities is billed under a joint user arrangement.

## Member

As used in conjunction with the Friends & Family Program, a Member is a GCI or MCI customer whose telephone number is included in a Calling Circle. A GCI or MCI customer may be a Member of an unlimited number of Calling Circles.

## Person-to-Person Calls

Operator assisted calls placed to a specific person.

## Physical Change

The modification of an existing circuit or service at the customer's request which involves the physical rearrangement of a circuit or facility or the reprogramming of service features. A physical change generally involves a change in the nature of the service or the manner in which it is provided.

## Premises

The space designated by a customer at its place or places of business for termination of GCICC service, whether for its own communication needs or for the use of its resale customers.

#### Service Order Form

A standard GCICC order form which includes all pertinent billing, technical and other descriptive information which will enable GCICC to provide the communication service as required.

#### Speed Dial

A signalling arrangement by which a customer may elect to dial a preprogrammed number in place of a designated multi-digit number.

#### Speed Line

A signalling arrangement by which a customer may automatically signal a pre-determined multi-digit telephone number without the requirement of any dialed digits.

#### Sub Account Code

A multi-digit code, which is available to customers. Individually assigned codes may be used to segregate billing according to the customers' desires.

#### Subscriber

As used in conjunction with the Friends & Family Program, a Subscriber is a GCI customer who undertakes to establish a Calling Circle by giving GCI a list of proposed Members and their telephone numbers (ANIs). A GCI customer can not be a Subscriber for more than one Calling Circle.

## Teleconference Account Codes

Authorization codes sold to a provider of teleconferencing services, enabling its subscribers to directly access a teleconference bridge.

#### Terminal Equipment

Devices, apparatus and their associated wiring, such as teleprinters, telephone handsets or data sets.

## 1. DESCRIPTION OF SERVICE

1.1 International Communication Service is the furnishing of GCICC services for communication between specified locations or areas under the terms of this tariff. The services will be provided by GCICC in conjunction with another carrier and a foreign administration or carrier connecting therewith.

1.2 GCICC, when acting at the customer's request and as his authorized agent, will make reasonable efforts to arrange for service requirements which may include terminal equipment.

## 2. LIMITATIONS

2.1 Service is offered subject to the availability of facilities and the provisions of this tariff.

2.2 GCICC reserves the right to discontinue furnishing service, upon written notice, when necessitated by conditions beyond its control or when the customer is using the service in violation of the provisions of this tariff, or in violation of the law.

## 3. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

3.1 The name(s) of the customer(s) and/or organization(s) desiring to use the service must be stipulated in the application for service. This provision is not intended to prohibit resale.

3.2 The customer is responsible for operating GCICC-provided equipment in a proper manner. Failure to do so will void GCICC liability for interruption of service and may make the customer responsible for damage to equipment pursuant to Section B.4 below.

3.3 Customer agrees to allow GCICC to remove all GCICC-provided equipment upon termination of the service interconnection with which the equipment was used. Said equipment shall be in the same condition as when delivered to customer, normal wear and tear only excepted.

# 4. LIABILITY

4.1 The liability of GCICC for damages arising out of mistakes, omissions, interruptions, delays, errors or defects in transmission occurring in the course of furnishing service, and not caused by the negligence of the customer or of GCICC in failing to maintain proper standards of maintenance and operation shall in no event exceed an amount equivalent to the proportionate charge to the customer for the period of service during which such mistake, omission, interruption, delay, error or defect in transmission occurs.

4.2 GCICC shall be indemnified and held harmless by the customer against:

4.2.1 claims for libel, slander, infringement of copyright and any other claims arising out of the material, data, information, or other content transmitted over GCICC's channels; and

4.2.2 patent infringement claims arising from combining or connecting GCICCfurnished channels with apparatus and systems of the customer; and

4.2.3 all other claims arising out of any act or omission of the customer in connection with any service provided by GCICC.

4.3 GCICC is not liable for any act or omission of any other company or companies furnishing a portion of the service.

4.4 GCICC does not guarantee or make any warranty with respect to any equipment provided by it where such equipment is used in locations containing an atmosphere which is explosive, prone to fire, dangerous or otherwise unsuitable for such equipment.

4.5 The customer indemnifies and holds GCICC harmless for any and all loss, claims, demands, suits, or other action, or any liability whatsoever, whether suffered, made, instituted or asserted by the customer or by any other party or persons, for any person injury to, or death of, any person or persons, and for any loss, damage or destruction of any property, whether owned by the customer or others, caused or claimed to have been caused directly or indirectly by the installation, operation, failure to operate, maintenance, removal, presence, condition, location or use of such equipment where such installation, operation, failure to operate, maintenance, result of GCICC's negligence.

## 4. LIABILITY (cont'd)

4.6 GCICC is not liable for any defacement of, or damage to, the premises of a customer resulting from the furnishing of channel facilities or the attachment of instruments, apparatus and associated wiring furnished by GCICC on such customer's premises or by the installation or removal thereof, when such defacement or damage is not the result of GCICC negligence. No agents or employees of other participating carriers shall be deemed to be agents or employees of GCICC.

4.7 The customer is responsible for taking all necessary legal steps for interconnecting his customer-provided terminal equipment or communication systems with GCICC facilities. He shall secure all licenses, permits, rights-of-way, and other arrangements necessary for such interconnection.

4.8 The customer shall insure that his equipment and/or system is properly interfaced with GCICC facilities, that the signals emitted into GCICC's network are of the proper mode, bandwidth, power, data speed, and signal level for the intended use of the customer, and that the signals do not damage GCICC equipment, injure personnel or degrade service to other customers. If the Federal Communications Commission or some other appropriate certifying body certifies terminal equipment as being technically acceptable for direct electrical connection with interstate or foreign communication service, GCICC will permit such equipment to be connected with its channels without the use of protective interface devices. If the customer fails to maintain and operate his equipment and/or system properly, with resulting imminent harm to GCICC equipment, personnel, or the quality of service to other customers, GCICC may, upon written notice, require the use of protective equipment at the customer's expense. If this fails to produce satisfactory quality and safety, GCICC may, upon written notice, terminate the customer's service. The applicable technical parameters will be provided to the customer upon request.

The communication services provided hereunder by GCICC shall be used only for lawful purposes.

## 6. PAYMENT ARRANGEMENTS

6.1 The customer is responsible for payment of all charges for services furnished to the customer. Charges for installation and administrative changes are payable upon completion. If, because of a cancellation of an order, a non-GCICC carrier or supplier levies charges, those charges shall be borne by the customer. Fixed recurring charges are billed in advance.

6.2 The customer will be billed for any excise, sales, franchise or other tax or assessment imposed by the Federal Government or any other governing body with regard to the communication services provided by GCICC.

6.3 Monthly bills will include a line item assessing a finance charge of .875% (up to a maximum of 10.5% annually) of the delinquent portion of the invoice (excluding any prior late fee assessments). A late charge of \$2.00 will be assessed each time an account goes from current to delinquent. Delinquent accounts are the accounts that are unpaid on the second bill cycle date.

6.4 Applicants or customers whose financial condition is not acceptable to GCICC, or is not a matter of general knowledge, may be required at any time to make a deposit up to an amount equaling the installation charges, if applicable, and up to three months' actual or estimated charges for the service to be provided or alternative assurance of payment must be arranged. In the case of a cash deposit, interest at the rate paid in that locality for escrow accounts will be paid for the period during which the deposit is held by GCICC. At GCICC's option, such deposit may be refunded or credited to the customer at any time prior to termination of service.

6.5 If notice of a dispute as to charges is not received in writing by GCICC within six months after an invoice is rendered, such invoice shall be deemed to be correct and binding upon the customer.

# 7. RESTORATION OF SERVICE

The use and restoration of service in emergencies shall be in accordance with Part 64, Subpart D of the Federal Communication Commission's Rules and Regulations, which specifies the priority system for such activities.

## 8. INSPECTION

GCICC may, upon reasonable notice, make such tests and inspections as may be necessary to determine that the requirements of this tariff are being complied with in the installation, operation or maintenance of the customer or GCICC equipment.

## 9. CANCELLATION FOR CAUSE BY GCICC

Upon non-payment of any sum owed to GCICC, or upon a violation of any of the provisions governing the furnishing of service under this tariff, GCICC may, upon written notification to the customer, without incurring any liability, immediately discontinue the furnishing of such service.

# 10. SPECIAL CUSTOMER ARRANGEMENTS

In cases where a customer requests special arrangements which may include engineering, installation, construction, assembly, purchase or lease of facilities, and/or other special services not offered under this tariff, GCICC, at its option, will provide the requested services. Appropriate recurring and/or non-recurring charges will be developed accordingly. Such charges will be tariffed on a case by case basis.

# SECTION C - SERVICE DESCRIPTIONS AND RATES

# 1. GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF INTERNATIONAL COMMUNICATION SERVICE

1.1 International Communication Service is offered to subscribers for communication between the United States and designated foreign countries on a switched basis at charges determined by the destination and duration of the call.

1.2 A customer may provide his own dedicated facilities to access GCICC's terminal location where such dedicated facilities are required.

1.3 GCICC offers its services subject to the availability of the necessary facilities and/or equipment. GCICC reserves the right to refuse to provide service to or from any location where the necessary facilities and/or equipment are not available. (See Section B.2.)

## 2. SPECIFICS OF INTERNATIONAL COMMUNICATION SERVICE

2.1 International Communication Service consists of the use of intercity and foreign communication facilities shared among multiple users, and is offered with various service options.

2.2 International Communication Services is a one-way multipoint service allowing the customer to originate calls via local telephone lines or via dedicated access lines from the customers' facilities and terminate calls via local telephone lines. Customers may originate IDDD and Operator Service calls only at GCICC origination points. Customers may originate GCICC Calling Card calls from GCICC origination points, the Contiguous 48 States, Hawaii, Puerto Rico, US Virgin Islands, and Canada. Customers may terminate calls at any foreign point specified herein.

## 3. SCHEDULE OF CHARGES

3.1 Classes of Service

The classes of service available to most countries include: International Direct Distance Dial (IDDD), Operator Station and Person-to-Person, Calling Card, and Satellite Cross-Linked Call Completion Service. The classes of service available to a country or area are indicated on the respective rate schedule. Sections 3.2 through 3.5 below apply to all countries except Canada. For information on Conference Calls, refer to Section C.5. For information on Satellite Cross-Linked Call Completion Service, refer to Section C.3.14.

## 3.2 Rate Periods

The rate period, (Standard, Discount, Economy) applies as specified for each country or area. All messages' minutes are rated according to the applicable rate period, regardless of whether a message begins in one period and ends in another Chargeable time for a rate period (e.g., 7AM-1PM) begins with the first stated hour (e.g. 7AM) and continues to, but does not include, the second stated hour (e.g. 1PM).

# 3.3 Initial Periods

3.3.1 The initial period for Operator Station and Person-to-Person is a minimum of three minutes. The initial period for IDDD service, Alaska originated Calling Card, and non-Alaska originated Calling Card calls is one minute.

3.3.2 The initial period rates for Operator Station and Person-to-Person calls are constant, on a twenty-four hours per day, seven days per week basis.

3.3.3 The initial period rates for Direct Dial and Alaska originated Calling Card calls are listed as "IDDD" in the rate schedule. The initial period rates for Operator Station calls are listed as "Station" in the rate schedule. The initial period rates for Person-to-Person calls are listed as "Person" in the rate schedule. The initial period rates for non-Alaska originated Calling Card calls are listed as "Card" in the rate schedule.

3.4 Additional Periods

3.4.1 For all calls, the additional period rates are for each additional minute, or any fraction thereof, that the telephone connection continues beyond the initial period.

3.4.2 The additional period rates for Direct Dial and Alaska originated Calling Card calls are listed as "IDDD" in the rate schedule. The additional period rates for Operator Station and Person-to-Person calls are listed as "Operator" in the rate schedule. The additional period rates for non-Alaska originated Calling Card calls are listed as "Card" in the rate schedule.

## 3.5 Rate Calculation

Charges are applicable to the total connect minutes of a message. The proper initial and number of additional periods shall be determined by using section C 3.8. The proper service type from section C 3.8 for the applicable country will determine the rate for each initial and additional period. The total rate shall be the sum of the initial period rate and the product of the additional period rate times the number of additional periods.

3.6 Definitions of terms in the rate schedule:

"12M" denotes twelve o'clock midnight
"12N" denotes twelve o'clock noon
"Operator" denotes Person-to-Person or Station-to-Station calls
"Person" denotes Person-to-Person calls (placed to a specified person)
"Station" denotes Station-to-Station calls (placed to a specified telephone)
"IDDD" denotes International Direct Distance Dial calls and Alaska originated Calling Card calls
"Card" denotes non-Alaska originated Calling Card calls

## 3.7 Applicable Rates for Specific Call Types

3.7.1 International Direct Distance Dialing (IDDD) - International Direct Distance Dialing is only available to those countries identified in this tariff as IDDD. Due to technical limitations in local company offices, IDDD Service is not available at all Alaska locations. Only specific locations identified in the tariff are eligible to receive the IDDD rate. IDDD rates are applicable 24 hours per day.

3.7.2 For Operator Calls originated in Alaska, the Operator Station or Person-to-Person rate, depending on how the call is placed, applies for the initial three minute period, or fraction thereof. For each additional minute, or fraction thereof, the rate from the applicable rate schedule applies to calls placed for the overseas country or area.

3.7.3 For Calling Card Calls not originated in Alaska, the initial period "Card" rate applies for the initial minute period, or fraction thereof. For each additional minute, or fraction thereof, the additional period "Card" rate from the applicable rate schedule applies to calls placed for the overseas country or area. For Calling Card Calls originated in Alaska through 950 access, GCICC "IDDD" rates apply plus an additional \$0.25 surcharge per call. For Calling Card Calls originated in Alaska through 800 access, GCICC "IDDD" rates apply plus an additional \$0.65 surcharge per call.

## 3.8 Times of Day

The time of day is determined at the origination point, with the following exception. The time of day for 800-accessed Calling Card calls is based upon Anchorage, Alaska time.
